You will need to supply the following: 1/3 yard (12" X 42") abric for frog's front and back, 7" X 22" fabric for the lily pad, 2"X12" red fabric for the mouth interior, 9" X12" piece of ironnn bonding adhesive such as Therm O Web's HeatnBond ®
Iltra HoldTM, 18" X 17" freezer paper, a little batting or poly fill or stuffing the leaf tip and frog's head, 4 cups of fine grade nuilder's sand or fine sawdust or cotton batting (add coins last to acrease weight and stability) to stuff the lily pad pin cushion.
