### Pattern & Necessities

(2004 Revised Edition)

Mr. Catchit likes to be fed sewing threads & fabric snippets. He also enjoys paper trimmings from children's projects. The mysterious leavings (coins, paperclips, ponytail holders, etc.) found in the washer & dryer at laundry time are pretty good too. Pennies tossed in by children are a special treat. He's allergic to flies.

contains: pattern, complete instructions with lots of diagrams, plus 16.5" mouth stiffener, 2 eye buttons and button spacers for that endearing bug-eyed horrified look.

You will need to supply the following: 1/3 yard (12" X 42") fabric for frog's front and back, 7" X 22" fabric for the lily pad, 2" X 12" red fabric for the mouth interior, 9" X 12" piece of iron-on bonding adhesive such as Therm O Web's HeatnBond® UltraHold™, 18" X 17" freezer paper, a little batting or poly fill for stuffing the leaf tip and frog's head, 4 cups of fine grade builder's sand or fine sawdust or cotton batting (add coins last to increase weight and stability) to stuff the lily pad pin cushion.

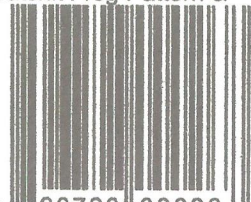
